

Mambo Kurt – Press text

There's days, when „ABBA“ is too heavy or „Slayer“ is too soft.. For every other mood, there is Mambo Kurt's new album „Spiel Heimorgel spiel“. Our beloved, slightly manic god of the keyboard has prepared a sweet composition of new-interpreted smash-hits on his sacred electric organ. As usual, he performs in his genuine style, putting a smile on the faces and a groove in the feet of every single one of his listeners. It is a pure joy how Mambo Kurt celebrates the high art of missing parts and not knowing how to sing. Every song is an homage to the originator. Nothing shakes a leg like a rhumba with 124 bpm. A good song stays a good song, also if played on on the biggest ever built home organ (which, by the way, can be bought in online auctions for the price of 50 €uro). And that is how you get „Rage against the machine“ as swing, „Nirvana“ as mambo, „Tina Turner“ as highspeed-polka and „Slayer“ as hardrock. As a secret special guest there is a feature by Mambos old organ-teacher Heidi Schulz, with a stunning performance of an amazing version of „God save the queen“. With her 87 years of age, the line in the lyrics „no future for me“ gets another, special meaning. Spiel Heimorgel spiel is a perfect partyhit and definitely the best release, Mambo Kurt has ever recorded in his living room: A perfect soundtrack for cleaning your kitchen, driving to work or simply making love.
